100 st georges terrace innercity office

The 24 storey mixed use development sits between the busy Hay Street Mall and the heart of Perth's CBD on St Georges Terrace providing an important pedestrian link between the two streets.

'100 St Georges Terrace' office tower, is the commercial component of the building. Consisting of 17 office storeys it connects to the Enex 100 podium, the retail sector of the building.

Utilising sustainable design features, the office tower has been awarded a 4 star "Office by Design V.2" Green Star rating and is currently aiming to achieve a 4.5 ABGR rating for the base building.



Sustainable design features include a cross over core approach designed for maximum tenant flexibility, use of high performance external glazing to reduce energy consumption while still allowing natural day light to penetrate into the building, and projecting sunshades to the northern facades which enhance energy performance all year round.

The retail component of this building, 'Enex 100' offers an exciting high end retail experience within the Perth CBD. A mixture of old and new, the building also integrates seamlessly with the existing historic facade.

Enex 100 covers three levels of retail with large supermarket chain Woolworths located at basement level. Boutique retail outlets featuring four metre high shop fronts are located on the ground floor and a contemporary Restaurant Court on the upper floor.

Enex 100 not only represents a contemporary and stylish mix to the Perth CBD, it has brought vibrancy and much needed activity back into the business district.

As one of the first users of Revit, Hames Sharley is positioned as industry forerunners in the usage of Building Information Modelling software within Australia and around the world.

Hames Sharley's current use of the Revit BIM extends to linking the building brief to the model. This enables verification of the brief with the design, static and walkthrough presentations of spaces and coordination of all engineering services documentation within a single model.
