new port office port of brisbane

The New Port Office is conceived as a responsive vessel for work. 1,000m² floor plates float above a three storey foyer with containers hanging into the void acting as meeting spaces.

The program is united vertically by an atrium with a series of stairs physically connecting the levels. Consideration to the internal qualities resulted in a focus to provide high quality air, light and materials.



Externally curving verandas provide breakout spaces & sky gardens for the staff and shade the building. These elements are a part of an integrated system of building elements working together to maximise the efficiency of the building and its occupation.

It is the first project in Australia to be awarded a rating under the Green Building Councils Version 3 rating tool.

The 5 Star (Australia Excellence) design rating is the beginning of a commitment to achieve a 5 star As-built and Office Fitout rating. The New Port Office will provide the Port of Brisbane Corporation with new head quarters that is aligned with their ongoing commitment to sustainability.

It will position them within a building that has been designed to maximise their work efficiencies and quality of life while at work, and establishing an identity for the Corporation.

Revit Architecture was used as an integral part of the design process with early models being used within design team meetings to aid in the resolution of issues.

All imaging of the model for marketing etc was produced using Revit Architecture's rendering and shading tools.
